hese tools are so new, we haven't had a chance to put them through their paces; indeed, some were not due for release until after the Tool Guide went to press. But if you are in the market for a tool in one of these categories, you should give the following serious consideration.

Lithium-ion powers drills in every size

Cordless drills powered by lithiumion batteries continue to proliferate because of their superior power and lighter weight compared to traditional batteries.

Milwaukee says that its 12v driver/drill has the best power-to-weight ratio in its class, with superior run time and performance. The drill will list for \$139 and be available starting Oct. 1, 2007.

A new mid-powered drill is Ridgid's 18v drill/driver, model No. R86006. The company says the lithium-ion battery can be recharged at least 2,000 times compared to 450 for a NiCd battery. The drill, charger, two batteries, and a contractor bag are \$179 at The Home Depot.

If boring holes in concrete is your thing, you will want to check out Panasonic's cordless rotary hammer drill. Despite having a 28.8v battery, the drill weighs only 8.4 lb. Other features include a slow-start switch for accurate drilling, soft or hard hammer action, and two speed ranges. With a charger and an extra battery, the drill costs \$629 and will be available in October 2007.
