OW MANY SUITCASES HAVE YOU purchased in your life only to find they don't hold up to your expectations? Well, it's worse with tool boxes. Hinges break, or more commonly something falls on it and SMASH the lid doesn't shut. Because the carrying handle is on the lid, it's into the trash for that tool box.

Cheer up, now we have VETO PRO PAC tool boxes, er, I mean tool bags. They will help you get organized and make you look like the professional you are.

These tool bags not only look tough they are tough. I don't think you can break these tool-organizing bags unless you try. All you have to do is look at the fine construction of these bags to realize somebody put a lot of thought into the construction.

The main body is weatherproof 1800 denier nylon fabric (good stuff) riveted to a 3 mm molded polypropylene plastic base. Now weather-proof doesn't mean submersed in a bathtub full of water, but you could set it in 3 inches of water with no problem. The zippers on the pockets are industrial strength — the kind you find on good sleeping bags. The shoulder strap is of strong 2inch-wide heavy duty webbing with a fixed 3-inch-wide shoulder pad making for an easy pack into the job. Okay, so you don't need the shoulder strap! The handgrip is a well-sized rubber grip that looks indestructible.

The small Model LC bag has 57 pockets of varying sizes enclosed behind the zippered panel fronts. It may be small at 13½ inches long, but, you can cram (organize) all kinds of small junk in it that will normally be at the



bottom of a regular tool box. No more dump-and-dig to find it.

The medium bag Model XL is $16^{1/2}$ inches long and little

higher and has 10 more pockets for storage. And, of course being larger, will hold more stuff. Still the same tough cookie as the other ones.

Now comes the one I like the Model XXL-F tool bag. Why do I like it so much? I am an infernal junk collector. I like to have all that little stuff: screws, nails, clips and doodads. This bad boy is 251/2 inches long and holds a gob of tools. The main reason I like it is the open bay on one side. You can store anything that will fit in it. If you need a square, it fits, a 2-foot level, no problem, drills, hammers, they fit. There are zippered pockets on all of the models on both sides for papers and small long
